TALKING POINTS

THE DIETITIAN LICENSURE COMPACT BILL GRANTS LICENSEES THE ABILITY TO PRACTICE ACROSS PARTICIPATING STATES AND REDUCES UNNECESSARY BARRIERS THAT HINDER WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT.

- Interstate occupational licensure compacts, like the Dietitian Licensure Compact, are constitutionally authorized, legally binding, legislatively enacted contract among states.
- By adopting S. 160, South Carolina will join approximately 20 states preparing to advance this legislation in the 2026 session, along with 15 that have already enacted it into law.
- Participation will reduce administrative burdens, improve operational efficiency, and provide access to a shared compact database that expedites licensure and disciplinary actions. The compact also enhances collaboration among state licensing boards in investigations and conflict resolution, while ensuring South Carolina retains full authority over licensees practicing within its borders.
