SCAND Diversity Mini Grant

Background:

The GOAL of the SCAND Diversity mini-grant is to increase/retain diversity in SCAND by offering partial rebates for Academy membership dues and full scholarships for the SCAND Annual Meeting to RD/RDNs, DTR/NDTR, students, interns, and unmatched interns in South Carolina who are from an underrepresented group according to the Academy's Diversity and Inclusion criteria.

Applicants must complete this survey including the last item which is to write a short essay on the importance of diversity in dietetics, and how they will foster diversity in the Academy, SCAND, and our profession, and how they meet the diversity definition.

The Academy's Diversity and Inclusion Statement: The Academy encourages diversity and inclusion by striving to recognize, respect and include differences in ability, age, creed, culture, ethnicity, gender, gender identity, political affiliation, race, religion, sexual orientation, size, and socioeconomic characteristics in the nutrition and dietetics profession.

Value:

Academy membership partial dues rebates for winners: student = \$50, non-retired RD/RDN/DTR/NDTR = \$200, retired RD/RDN/DTR/NDTR = \$100. Actual Academy membership dues: student = \$58, non-retired RD/RDN/DTR/NDTR = \$250, retired RD/RDN/DTR/NDTR = \$117.

SCAND 2021 annual meeting scholarships for same winners (based on 2020 annual meeting): student = \$50, non-retired RD/RDN/DTR/NDTR = \$100, retired RD/RDN/DTR/NDTR = \$50.

September 16, 2020 is the deadline to apply.

Winners will be notified by 10/1/2020.

Winners must agree to have their names and photos shared, for example in the SCAND newsletter, the Diversity and Inclusion page of the SCAND website, and perhaps with the Academy. Also, winners must agree to attend at least 2 district/SCAND events plus the annual meeting. District dues will be waived for winners. District Presidents will be asked to reach out to winners located in their district, invite them to events, possibly appoint them to committees, and perhaps arrange rides with them to the SCAND Annual Meeting in Columbia (unless it is virtual).
